

Section Officer Information Sheet

This form has been developed to aid an Arrowman in the approval process to run for a section office, as well as provide a description of the duties and expectations of a Section Officer

- THE PURPOSE OF THE SECTION IS TO SUPPORT THE LODGE. If an Arrowman is needed by their lodge in a critical position, they shouldn't run for Section office. The Lodge comes before the Section.
- All Officers must be under 21 years of age for the entire term of office.
- If an Arrowman runs for office, they must be prepared to fulfill the office.

Please remember that all candidates **MUST** have the signature of their council's Scout Executive or designee. All forms, with appropriate signatures, **MUST** be received by the Section Adviser by lunch the Saturday of Conclave. These candidate forms will be accepted at any COC meeting prior to the conclave or completed forms can be sent to the Section Adviser, Terri Andrews, via email at tandrews@oa-e13.org.

Section Officer Responsibilities:

ATTENDANCE

- Officers of Section E13 are required to attend all Council of Chiefs meetings, officer meetings, the annual section Conclave, FORUM, the Eastern Region Section Officers Seminar and the National Order of the Arrow Program of Emphasis (if applicable).
- The Section Chief is required to attend the Order of the Arrow National Planning Meeting in December.
- Officers are encouraged to attend as many functions of the E13 Lodges as possible during the year. These are opportunities to strengthen the bonds between the lodges within the section.
- Officers are expected to remain active in their home troop and/or crew.
- Officers must be able to provide their own transportation to all events. BSA transportation rules must be followed.

UNIFORMING

- Officers of Section E13 are required to be in proper, clean Scout uniform whenever representing the Section and/or Order of the Arrow.
- Uniform patches must be placed correctly according to the Scout Handbook.

DUTIES

- Most duties are found in the Field Operations Handbook; which can be found on the National Order of the Arrow website www.oa-bsa.org.
- Specific duties may be assigned by either the Section Chief or the Council of Chiefs throughout the year.
- All officers are expected to communicate with the Section Adviser or their designee on at least a weekly basis throughout the program year.

COMMITMENT

- Being a Section Officer is a big commitment. Performing the duties of the job involves a significant amount of time, energy and travel.
- Scouting activities are secondary to family, church and school responsibilities.
- If your present responsibilities are time demanding (e.g.: sports, difficult school classes, family responsibilities, etc.), then you need to consider where the OA fits in to your life before deciding to run for Section office.
- The Section Chief may not serve simultaneously as a Lodge Chief (or in any other elected position). Therefore, if you have any intention of running for another position, please discuss this with your Lodge Adviser and decide whether you can best serve the OA in the Lodge or in the Section.
